A Word About 10 Miles Outside Damascus

Welcome to the World Premier Presentation of 10 Miles Outside Damascus – a David Meece original musical with arrangements by Dennis Willen.

David Meece is a groundbreaking pioneer of the Contemporary Christian Music genre and a member of the Christian Music Hall of Fame. His musical works have impacted worldwide audiences for generations. This contemporary rock musical features over 2 dozen original songs as it takes us on the journey of Paul as he is transformed from a chief prosecutor of the early Christian church to a bold and tireless leader for the cause of Christ.

10 Miles Outside Damascus is an updated presentation of what was originally presented in 1972 as Paul: A Rock Opera. The original script was lost in a fire and has been in re-development for several years. The musical arrangements were redeveloped and modernized by Dennis Willen.

A further note—Paul is never referred to as Saul during this production. Many of us know of Paul the missionary and writer of at least 13 books of the Bible, but Paul is also known as Saul. In Biblical times, it was common to have dual names. Saul` was his Hebrew name and Paul his Roman name. As the missionary to Gentiles, or non-jews including Romans, he is referred to more commonly as Paul.

Paul Describes his Conversion in Acts 26:

¹² "On one of these journeys I was going to Damascus with the authority and commission of the chief priests. ¹³ About noon, King Agrippa, as I was on the road, I saw a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, blazing around me and my companions. ¹⁴We all fell to the ground, and I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, 'Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads*.'

15 "Then I asked, 'Who are you, Lord?' 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting,' the Lord replied. ¹⁶ 'Now get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you to appoint you as a servant and as a witness of what you have seen and will see of me. 17 I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles. I am sending you to them ¹⁸ to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.' ¹⁹ "So then, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the vision from heaven. ²⁰ First to those in Damascus, then to those in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and then to the Gentiles, I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their repentance by their deeds.

*A goad is a type of long stick with a pointed end used to guide livestock, which are pulling a plow or a cart.

His life continues to impact millions worldwide and his passion for excellence in the field of Contemporary Christian Music will leave a powerful legacy for generations to come. 
