A Word From Our Director

Theatre and reading have always been important to me. I love the way in which a story is told and presented. I find different adaptations of the same work to be fascinating and insightful. And when word and image combine with song, dance, and a live orchestra — something magical happens. As an audience, we each bring our own unique experiences with us when we come to the theater.

Hans Christian Andersen's original 1837 story "The Little Mermaid" has expanded far beyond the original text. The initial fable focuses on longing, identity, sacrifice, transformation, and the desire to belong in a world beyond one's own. While the ending is much more tragic, as an audience we see a fifteen year old child grow up both spiritually and emotionally. Later adaptations have taken those same lessons and morphed the ideas. Ariel's journey in the 1989 animated film centers on curiosity, independence, and finding her own voice (both literally and figuratively) while still reflecting the original story's theme of pursuing a life that feels authentic. The stage adaptation expands these themes further by emphasizing forgiveness, reconciliation, and understanding between different worlds.

The reason *The Little Mermaid* endures throughout time is because the story helps us relate to the human experience. We grow up. We make difficult choices - choices that define who we are and who we want to be. We discover new things about ourselves. We dream. We balance dreams with responsibility.

Classic stories help bring out the best versions of people because they ask meaningful questions about who we are and what we are willing to risk to become ourselves.

Some of you may remember the heartbreak of a nameless little mermaid in Hans Christian Andersen's original tale, others may turn up the volume to sing every word of "Part of your World" at the top of your lungs from Disney's animated film, and still others may bring memories of the live action, Broadway, or televised version with them to the theater.

Whichever version of *The Little Mermaid* you carry in your heart, we hope the magic of live theater inspires you. We hope you enjoy your time under the sea.

What does this mean? A Little Mermaid Glossary

Barnacle: a crustacean (related to crabs and lobsters) that can attach to and grow on ships, rocks or even whales.

Bow: the front of the ship. The rear of the ship is called the stern.

Crinoline: a petticoat of haircloth or other stiff material, worn under a full skirt to keep it belled out.

Fathoms: a unit of water depth equal to 6 feet. That means a mile is 880 fathoms.

Flotsam and Jetsam: not just Ursula's electric-eel sidekicks! Flotsam is the name for debris that floats up to the surface after a shipwreck. Jetsam is the name for items that are jettisoned, intentionally thrown overboard, from a ship/shipwreck. (Jetsam also floats, by the way, so most of Ariel's collection of human stuff is not flotsam or jetsam – it's derelict, items that sink to the ocean floor.)

Harpoons: long spears used at sea for fishing, whaling, and other marine hunting.

Hook, line & sinker: as in "I fell for that hook, line & sinker" comes from fishing: the fish swallows the hook (holds the bait), the line (reels in the fish), and the sinker (weighs the bait down to stay under-water). In the words of Sebastian, "guess who's gon' be on the plate?"

Mainsail: the sail on the tallest ship mast.

Meerschaum pipe: a rare, lightweight mineral (sepiolite) made of the fossilized remains of microscopic sea creatures. It translates to "sea foam" in German.

Rigging: the system of lines and masts that allow sailors to control the sails.

Siren: from Mythology, one of several sea nymphs, part woman/part bird, who lure sailors to destruction by seductive singing.

Starboard: your right, when facing the front of the ship. Left is called port, which is a place where ships can take shelter.

Windward: the side of the ship that faces the direction the wind is coming from. The opposite is **Leeward**, the side of the ship that faces the direction the wind is going.
